MVP Fight Week Showcase 2 takes place Tuesday, November 11 at 6pm ET, featuring Jake vs. Tank open workouts and four sanctioned, professional bouts from MVP’s US Olympian Jahmal Harvey, MVP’s Brazilian Olympian Keno Marley, Nazareno Romero, and Kaipo Gallegos

MVP Jake vs. Tank Press Conference takes place Wednesday, November 12 at 6pm ET

MVP Jake vs. Tank Public Weigh-Ins take place Thursday, November 13 at 6pm ET

All fight week events will take place at Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino and are free and open to the public to attend on a first-come, first-served basis

MIAMI, FLORIDA – October 23, 2025 – Most Valuable Promotions (MVP) and Netflix today announced fight week schedule for Jake vs. Tank, headlined by boxing’s biggest disruptor, international superstar, and the WBA’s #14 ranked cruiserweight **Jake “El Gallo de Dorado” Paul** (12-1, 7 KOs) vs. undefeated three-division champion, reigning WBA world champion, and pound-for-pound great **Gervonta “Tank” Davis** (30-0-1, 28 KOs). As part of the build-up to the boxing mega-event at Kaseya Center in Miami, Florida, on Friday, November 14, MVP and Netflix will host three fight week events at Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino in Hollywood, Florida. Kicking off the week, MVP Fight Week Showcase 2 will feature Jake vs. Tank open workouts alongside four sanctioned professional bouts. All fight week events will be free and open to the public on a first come, first served basis.

On **Tuesday, November 11**, MVP Fight Week Showcase 2 will take place at Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino, featuring open workouts for Jake vs. Tank and four sanctioned professional fights, starting at 6:00 p.m. ET / 3:00 p.m. PT. The second installment of MVP's fight week showcase bouts will be headlined by MVP's US Olympian **Jahmal Harvey** (1-0, 1 KO) vs. **Kevin Cervantes** (5-0, 5 KO) in a 6-round super featherweight bout at 130lbs. Also on the card will be 18x national amateur champion **Kaipo Gallegos** (10-0-1, 8 KO) vs. **Cristian Perez** (12-3-1, 7 KO) in an 8-round lightweight bout at 135lbs and MVP's Brazilian Olympian **Keno Marley** making his pro debut vs. **Diarra Davis Jr.** (2-1, 1 KO) over 4 rounds at 200lbs in the cruiserweight division. Opening the card will be **Nazarena Romero** (14-1-2, 8 KO) vs. **Mayerlin Rivas** (17-6-3, 11 KO) in an 8-round bout at 122lbs in the super bantamweight division. These fights will be officially sanctioned by the Florida Athletic Commission. The entire event, including the four fights, will stream live on [MVP's YouTube Channel](#) and [Netflix Sports' YouTube Channel](#).

On **Wednesday, November 12**, MVP and Netflix will host the official final Press Conference for Jake vs. Tank at Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino starting at 6:00pm ET / 3:00pm PT. The press conference will feature the final war of words between main event stars Jake Paul and Tank Davis, co-main event stars Alycia Baumgardner and Leila Beaudoin, as well as all undercard fighters, and will stream live on [MVP's YouTube Channel](#) and [Netflix Sports' YouTube Channel](#).

On **Thursday, November 13**, MVP and Netflix will host the Jake vs. Tank public weigh-in, streaming live from Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino at 6:00pm ET / 3:00pm PT on [MVP's YouTube Channel](#) and [Netflix Sports' YouTube Channel](#).

On **Friday, November 14**, Jake vs. Tank streams live on Netflix from Kaseya Center in Miami, Florida. The preliminary card begins at 4:45pm ET / 2:00pm PT on [MVP's YouTube Channel](#) and Netflix's [Tudum](#), with the main card starting at 8:00pm ET / 5:00pm PT, live only on Netflix.

"Jake vs. Tank is one of the biggest events in boxing history, and we've built an unforgettable fight week to match it, all happening at Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino in Hollywood, FL," **said Nakisa Bidarian, CEO and co-founder of Most Valuable Promotions.** "It kicks off with MVP Fight Week Showcase 2, our new signature series of sanctioned professional fights within our open workouts event, featuring world-class talents like MVP Olympians Jahmal Harvey and Keno Marley, alongside Kaipo Gallegos and Nazarena Romero. The week continues with a massive press conference and our public weigh-in, with all events free and open to the public. This will be a full week of world-class boxing and star power that set the stage for Friday night's historic mega-event in Miami."

US Olympian and amateur world champion **Jahmal Harvey** was introduced to boxing at age 13 by his football coach Darrell Davis, who also owned a boxing gym. After competing in both sports, Harvey, an Oxon Hill, Maryland native, soon went all-in on boxing and immediately proved his elite potential at the junior, youth, and amateur levels, becoming a 10x national champion. By 18, he was training and sparring with Olympians, including Keyshawn Davis and Duke Ragan. The same year, he captured gold at the 2021 Elite World Championships, the first American male to win the world title since 2007, while competing as one of the youngest athletes in the tournament. The next year, he took home silver at the 2022

Continental Championships and continued to dominate at the international level in 2023, winning gold at the Santiago Pan American Games. The finish qualified him for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, where he finished as a quarter-finalist. The 22-year-old won by first round TKO in his professional debut on MVP's Most Valuable Prospects 14, heralded as one of the top prospects in American boxing.

"It's great to be back and part of such a huge event!" **said Jahmal Harvey.** "I'm looking to deliver an emphatic performance and show the world why I will be the MVP of the sport."

Kevin Cervantes (5-0, 5 KOs) comes to the ring from Los Angeles by way of Barranquilla, Colombia. The 25-year-old prospect holds a perfect undefeated record so far in his pro career, and comes to the ring fresh from his latest first-round TKO win in September 2025. He began boxing at just 11 years old after his parents introduced him to the sport to channel his energy and fighting spirit productively. With an impressive 87-fight amateur background, Cervantes has developed into a relentless brawler known for his aggressive, high-pressure style reminiscent of his idol, Roberto "Manos de Piedra" Durán. Defined by his hard work, discipline, and commitment, Cervantes continues to build his name in the professional ranks as one of the sport's most determined young fighters. He is managed by Rob Suarez and trained by Oscar Negrete.

18x national champion **Kaipo Gallegos** is a Las Vegas native. He is currently ranked #15 in the world by the WBA at just 19 years old, formerly held the WBO Youth World title, and is promoted by Shuan Boxing and Boxlab Promotions. He has also featured twice on MVP's Most Valuable Prospects series, winning both bouts by TKO.

Gallegos will face 27-year-old **Cristian Perez.** Perez comes to the ring from Monterrey, Mexico, having most recently contested for the WBO NABO super featherweight title in September 2025.

Keno Marley is a 25-year-old 6'3" boxer born in Sapeaçu, Bahia, Brazil. He first began boxing at age 11 before moving to São Paulo alone to pursue his boxing training at age 13, joining the Brazilian national team to launch a standout amateur career. He first made a name for himself at the 2018 Summer Youth Olympics in Buenos Aires, taking home the gold medal and becoming the first Brazilian boxer to achieve this feat. The next year, Marley earned silver at the 2019 Pan American championships. He earned a place on Brazil's Olympic team, qualifying to compete in the men's light heavyweight event at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and finishing as a quarter-finalist in a narrow 3-2 defeat to Britain's Benjamin Whittaker, the eventual silver medalist. At the 2021 amateur world championships, Marley fought in the IBA cruiserweight division and earned the silver medal, before becoming the 2022 Brazilian national amateur champion. In 2023, Marley won the prestigious Strandja Tournament, the biggest championship on the European circuit, becoming the first Brazilian man to reach the final and win the title before winning silver at the 2023 Pan American Games. He continued his amateur sprint as he returned to represent Brazil again at the Paris 2024 Olympics in the men's heavyweight division, once again reaching the quarter finals. Outside boxing, Marley faced two difficult losses in 2021, losing his older brother to murder and his cousin to suicide. He now actively serves as a third sergeant in the Brazilian Army, holds a university degree in physical education, and is currently completing a law degree. He trains out of the Brazilian

Olympic Training Center and is co-managed by Brazil's biggest influencer, multi-talented superstar Whindersson Nunes. He resides in São Paulo, Brazil.

"I was supposed to debut in June, but the injury set me back for a reason," **said Keno Marley**. "It gave me time to recover, refocus, and come back stronger. I've already represented my country on the Olympic stage, and now I get to step into the pro ranks during Jake vs Tank fight week. The spotlight is huge, and I'm ready to make a statement."

Diarra Davis Jr. is a 34-year-old southpaw from Baltimore, Maryland. Standing at 6'2" and competing in the 175-lb division, Davis has demonstrated determination and composure early in his professional career, holding a record of 2 wins and 1 loss. In May 2025, he stepped onto the international stage in Mayagüez, Puerto Rico, where he went the distance against local prospect Bradley Olmeda in a competitive four-round bout. Though he came up short on the scorecards, the performance showcased his resilience and willingness to take on challenges beyond his home turf. With his size, skill, and drive, Davis continues to progress as one of the promising fighters emerging from the Baltimore boxing scene.

Nazarena Romero is the former WBA super bantamweight world champion at 122lbs from Cordoba, Argentina. After holding the WBA Interim title since 2020, Romero captured the full world championship in 2024 with a commanding ninth-round TKO victory over Paulette Valenzuela Cuesta. Prior to winning the title in 2024, she faced Mayerlin Rivas in a tightly contested world title bout that ended in a draw, solidifying her reputation as one of the division's most skilled and durable competitors.

Mayerlin Rivas is a former WBA super bantamweight world champion celebrated for her power, precision, and championship pedigree. From Caracas, Venezuela, Rivas began boxing at 16, inspired by her uncle and cousins who also competed in the sport. Managed by Marcelo González and trained by Jorge Zerpa, she has built a decorated career defined by discipline and resilience. With an impressive amateur record of 30 fights, including 27 wins by knockout, Rivas developed into a stylistic, calculated fighter who combines finesse with determination. In 2023, she successfully defended her WBA title against Argentina's Nazarena Romero in a thrilling matchup that showcased her experience, adaptability, and enduring dominance on the world stage.
