THE GLOBAL LIVE SPORTS EVENT JAKE VS. JOSHUA: JUDGMENT DAY WILL STREAM EXCLUSIVELY ON NETFLIX ON FRIDAY, DECEMBER 19

MIAMI, FL – December 16, 2025 – Today at LIV at Fontainebleau Miami Beach, international superstar and WBA #15-ranked cruiserweight Jake "El Gallo de Dorado" Paul (12-1, 7 KOs) and two-time unified WBO, WBA, and IBF heavyweight world champion, Olympic gold medalist and knockout machine Anthony "AJ" Joshua (28-4, 25 KOs) showcased their skills at MVP Fight Week Showcase 2.

Fighters on the main and preliminary cards participated in the open workout, including MVP's undisputed super featherweight world champion Alycia "The Bomb" Baumgardner (16-1, 7 KOs) and Canada's #2 IBF, #3 WBO, and #3 WBA contender Leila Beaudoin (13-1, 2 KOs). Additional fighters included MMA GOATs Anderson "The Spider" Silva (3-2, 2 KOs) and Tyron Woodley (3-2, 2 KOs), alongside MVP's US Olympian and amateur world champion Jahmal Harvey (1-0, 1 KO), MVP and Australia's undisputed bantamweight world champion Cherneka "Sugar Neekz" Johnson (18-2, 8 KOs), and MVP's newest signee and WBC lightweight world champion "Sweet" Caroline Dubois (11-0-1, 5 KOs).

MVP Fight Week Showcase 2 also featured three sanctioned professional fights. Opening the event, MVP and England's Shannon "The Baby Face Assassin" Courtenay (10-3, 3 KOs) defeated Jessica Radtke Maltez (2-3-2) in a 6-round bantamweight bout where Courtenay took home her first-ever win by unanimous decision (60-54 x2, 58-56) in her promotional debut. MVP's Nat "No Love" Dove (7-0-1, 2 KOs) defeated Perla "La Princesa" Lomeli (7-7, 1 KOs) in a 6-round lightweight bout where Dove remained undefeated with a unanimous decision (57-55 x2, 58-54) win over Lomeli. In the final fight of the Showcase, MVP's new signee Luan Medeiros (7-0, 4 KOs) defeated Mexico's Hugo Macias (7-2-1, 5 KOs) in a 6-round lightweight bout as Medeiros maintained his undefeated record with a unanimous decision (60-54 x3) win over Macias.

Fans and media gathered in large numbers to witness the event, which gave a preview of the action to come.

MVP's Jake vs. Joshua: Judgment Day will stream live globally on Netflix this Friday, **December 19 at 8:00pm ET / 5:00pm PT** from Kaseya Center in Miami, Florida.

MVP was founded by Jake Paul and Nakisa Bidarian in 2021. With the mission to provide more creative control to fighters, MVP works to identify, grow, and maximize return for its own events and talent partners. One year into its inception, MVP was nominated as one of the prestigious Sports Breakthroughs of the Year in 2022 by Sports Business Journal. MVP have produced Jake Paul's last seven global pay-per-view events, including the recent Paul vs. Chavez Jr. match. The promotion company also signed one of the most decorated Hispanic athletes of all time, Amanda Serrano in its first year. Serrano and MVP made history in April of 2022 when Serrano went head to head with Katie Taylor, marking the first female fight to headline at Madison Square Garden, earning a nomination for Event of The Year by Sports Business Journal. MVP made history again in November 2024 with Jake Paul vs. Mike Tyson and Katie Taylor vs. Amanda Serrano 2, the first-ever live professional sports event on Netflix. MVP's Paul vs. Tyson streamed live globally on Netflix and shattered records, becoming the most-streamed sporting event ever with 108 million live viewers globally. Co-founder Nakisa Bidarian was an executive producer of Paul vs. Tyson and the historic Triller Presents Mike Tyson v. Roy Jones Jr., which was the 8th most bought pay-per-view event in history.
